This year's Times Holiday Appeal fund drive began on Thanksgiving Day and already has raised \$2,905 in contributions.

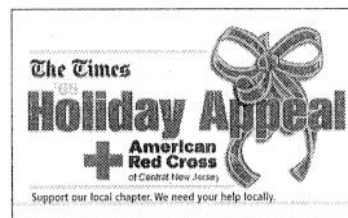
